### THE CHIPPING HEARSE

Senior Chippiners will remember the ancient hearse which was kept in outbuildings at the Sun Inn until about 1957, when it was sold to a private museum. There seems to be no memory of it being used. It was a massive two-horse carriage with big wheels and strong springs, built sturdily of oak to withstand rough journeys from outlying farms and the deep ruts of the public roads. There were two seats at the front and a box construction, unpainted but covered with carvings, to hold the coffin.
