Maria Sanders married Henry Marsden, the coachman at the Hall. They lived at Leagram Lodge in the early years of their marriage. On the front cover of this book she is shown with her children in the doorway of the Lodge. Her daughter May is sitting on the doorstep on the left, son Henry in the centre, and a cousin on the right. Baby Joseph is in his mother's arms.

In the centre, Mr Essinger, a German, who was employed as butler at the Hall during the First World War. Because of his nationality he was interned, and he was required to visit Chipping Post Office daily to report his whereabouts.
